



About Giant Snakes & Ladders

Take the classic game of Snakes and Ladders to a whole new level! This giant version puts you in the heart of the game where YOU move up the ladders and down the snakes.

An active, family-friendly game that's great for all ages. New rules have been added for extra fun!

Game Setup

This game is best played outdoors on a grassy lawn.

Unfold the giant plastic mat and lay it out flat on the grass. Use the pegs provided to secure the mat to the ground. Grab the dice, and you're ready to roll!

How to Play

- 1) To decide the order, each player takes a turn to roll the dice. Whoever rolls the highest number goes first, with the next highest number following, and so on.
- 2) On your turn to play, throw the dice. Starting at square one, move forward on the board based on the number you rolled. (i.e., if you rolled a 4, you move 4 squares).
- 3) If you end up at the foot of a ladder, move up to the square at the top of the ladder. If you end up on the head of a snake, then slide back down to the square at its tail.
- 4) More than one person can occupy the same square at a time

Special Squares

- If you land on a '**Sting Square**', you can swap places with another player - the choice is up to you. The only rule is that you **MUST** swap, even if you're in the lead at the time.

- If you land on a '**Double Dice Square**', your next throw of the dice counts as DOUBLE. You **MUST** double up your score, even if it means you reach the winner square and then have to bounce backwards using the full value of the dice thrown.
- If you land on a '**Stand on One Leg Square**', then you **MUST** do exactly that until your next throw of the dice. If any other part of your body touches the ground before your next turn, you will need to move backwards based on the number you roll on your next turn.

How to Win

You must throw exactly the right number to get home. If you roll a higher number, you must move forwards onto the winner square and then backwards using the full value of the dice thrown.

The first player to finish their turn on the home square wins!
