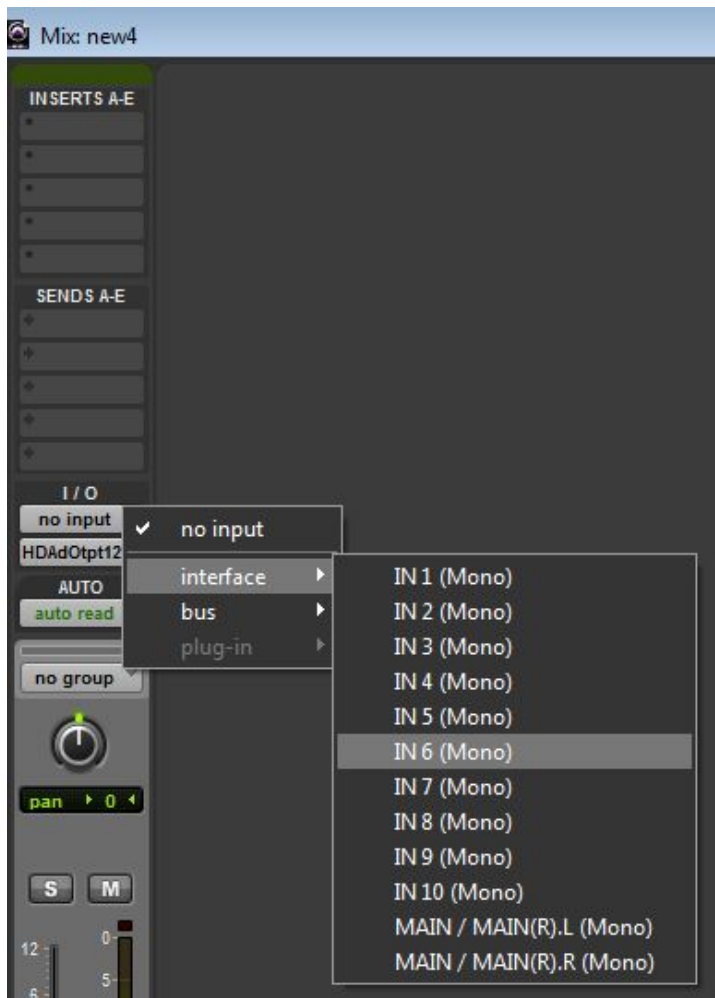


# Using The Talk-back Microphone

## Used To Communicating With Artists Inside the Recording Studio

1. In Pro Tools 12, create an **Aux Track** by clicking on **Track > New**, and change **Audio Track** in the dropdown menu to **Aux Input**. Click **Create**.
2. In the Mix Window, change the **I/O** setting on the track by clicking on **No Input > Interface > IN 6**. Shown below:



3. Verify that the power switch on the talk-back microphone is turned to **ON**. Shown below:



4. You may now communicate inside the recording booth using the talk-back microphone. The signal will be transmitted through the **speakers** and the **headphones** if the appropriate channel is turned on with the **Headamp 6**.
5. This microphone can also be used to record vocals. To do so, follow the standard procedure for recording vocals from the help sheets.
6. Please remember to turn talk-back microphone to the **OFF** position when not in use.
