


Saving Unfinished Sessions & Opening Unfinished Sessions

- Session files do not save to the Audio Recording Studio computer. **YOU** must save sessions to an external hard drive/USB or session will not be saved

- ✓ Before beginning a session, it is always a good idea to **check how much space you have available on your storage device** so that you avoid potential problems later down the road. To do so, from the toolbar menu, select **Window > Disk Usage**. A window will pop up indicating how many minutes you have available on your storage device for recording. For example, the removable USB key indicated below has 96.9 minutes of space available at a 44.1 kHz 24 Bit Track setting.

Saving Unfinished Sessions

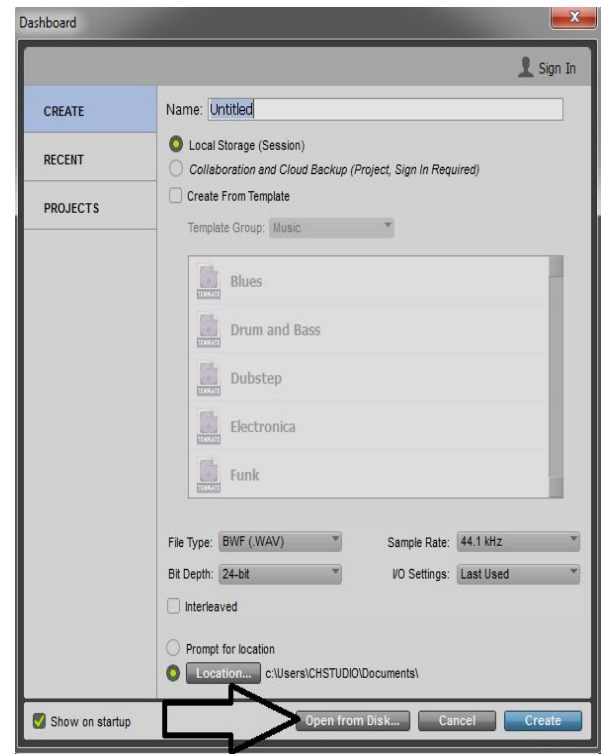
1. To save a session that is unfinished, insert your storage device into the computer.
2. In Pro Tools 12, Click **File > Save**.
3. Open the **Windows Explorer** File Manager.
4. All saved sessions will be located under **C:/Users/CHSTUDIO/Documents**, and then the name of the session.
5. Click and hold the folder with your session name, and drag and drop it into your storage device. Your

folder will now be copied over to your storage device.

6. Safely remove your storage device.

Opening a Saved Session

1. Insert Storage Device.
2. Open Pro Tools 12.
3. From the **Dashboard**, Select, **Open From Disk** as shown below.



4. Select your storage device.
5. Open the appropriate folder.
6. Click on the Pro Tools 12 session file.
7. Pro Tools 12 will restore your previously saved session.
